Things you should know before applying to Odyssey House

Odyssey House is a sober living recovery environment for adult men that uses the proven effective methods of the 12 step programs. Recovery is a long process and we believe that the community and support provided at this House will help you to meet your goals early in recovery and prepare you to live a life in recovery in our society. During your participation in our program, you will be required to actively cooperate with the Odyssey House program in all ways, including:

- Service fee is \$100.00 per week and is due on Saturday, by 5:00 P.M.
- 2 residents per room
- You will be required to review and accept the rules and regulations of the house.
- Substance abuse of any kind will not be tolerated while you are a resident of Odyssey House.
- You must sign legal consent to the release of information about you, between Odyssey House and other agencies, doctors, and therapists, with which you are involved.
- Your personal living area will be subject to inspection and searches.
- You will be subject to random drug screenings.
- You will continue to take as prescribed any prescription medication. All medications will be locked in staff office.
- Odyssey House is not able to work with residents using some replacement drug therapies.
- You will deal responsibly with your legal, financial, family and health issues.
- You will be expected to find and maintain a job.
- All residents will be expected to perform their service commitment.
- You will be required to show proof of insurance, registration and a valid driver's license for any vehicle you use while a resident.
- You will attend mandatory AA and/or NA meetings and recovery groups. You will be required to get a sponsor and maintain regular contact with him.
- You will share household chores, including meal preparation.
- You will establish recovery goals and will review them regularly.
- If rules are not followed termination of residency can result.
